FREE PRACTICE 1

P9

A great start to the weekend finishing in P9. We had initially come into this weekend with some data from a pre-season test we did here in March. It gave us the settings and gearing we needed to start off strong! The gap to P1 was a little bit bigger than we'd like, but with the level of the field this season we knew that it would be a very fast pace from session 1 and confident to close that gap to the leader.

SUPERPOLE

P19

What a hot session that was! My record for highest temperature I have ridden in. Friday afternoon and we were faced with 36 degrees air temp, and a whopping 60 degrees track temperature. On top of this, the heat coming up from the bike was something I had never experienced before, so a bit of a struggle. We ended up finishing in P19, after struggling with a bit of track position as well, we had some work to do for the first race of the weekend.

WARM UP 1

P2

A great start to our Saturday. The much cooler conditions helped me have a much better feeling with the bike, which meant I could push harder and ended up finding over a second compared to my quickest time of the weekend so far. Shame I didn't do that in qualifying! However, we didn't take this as a negative, our warmup session proved we had the pace to be at the front, and at this point of the weekend being 1 of the 3 riders to be into that lap time bracket, I knew if we had a strong opening 3 laps, we would have a good race underway.

RACE 1

P8

Another top 10 finish for me and the PHR Performance crew! But not just this, we had a goal of being inside the front group at the start of the weekend, and that's exactly what we did, from P19 on the grid! Making up 11 places in Saturday's race, in a field this strong was incredibly motivating. Our true pace is really coming out to show, and I was excited to carry this momentum forward to race 2.

WARM UP 2

A session that was cut short stopped us from getting some good laps in before race 2. Once again feeling good in the cooler conditions, a red flag after 5 minutes stopped anymore track action. Although, the start of the session I was able to practice some overtakes I feel would be important in the race.

RACE 2

We are World Sportbike Podium finishers! After a hard fought 55km 11 lap race, we secured our first podium finish of the year! A phenomenal way to end the weekend standing on the box. Fighting every single corner with some of the best riders in the world was something special, learning chunks has really given me some experience that I can take forward into the 2nd half of our season. I am so proud of myself and the PHR Performance team, we have come such a long way together from the start of our journey in 2025. Especially after our tricky result on Friday afternoon in Superpole, we dug deep, believed, and pulled out a result that will be an incredible milestone in my career...
